- A finished Master's degree or equivalent in business, tech, or any studies related to mobility, transport and sustainability is required (latest at the start of the program in February 2024).
- Fluency in English is required, German is beneficial.

Application

- The application period starts on **1st August 2023**, and will end on **2nd September 2023**. During that period, you can upload your documents directly via our **GMT** website.
- Make sure to upload all documents and submit your Aivy ID, as we will only consider applications that are completed on time.
- We are particularly interested in what exactly you have done that relates to sustainability (internship, Bachelor's thesis, Master's thesis, major, etc.).

Pre-Selection

- On **7th September 2023** at the latest, you will receive your invite for the teams interview if you successfully passed the online test.
- From **11th September 2023** to **15th September 2023**, the video interviews will take place.
- Please ensure to block the dates for possible interviews and the assessment day in your calendar as we unfortunately cannot offer alternative dates.
- Preparation for the 30-minutes pre-selection interview: **Why am I the right candidate** for the Green Mobility Trainee Program?

Selection

- From **18th September 2023** to **20th September 2023**, the final candidates will be invited to the applicant's day.
- On **16th, 17th or 19th October 2023**, your applicant day will take place.
- Latest on **24th October 2023**, the 10 final candidates will have received the offer call.
- From **24rd to 27th October 2023**, contracts will be sent out to the chosen trainees and need to be returned to us within one week.
- On **30th October 2023**, the waiting list candidates will get final feedback on their application and receive an offer if applicable.
